Code of Conduct

The Code of Conduct outlined below applies to all Members and Staff of Walthamstow Trades Hall and is in place to support a peaceful and sociable environment.

As a Club Member or Staff Member, I agree to the follow statements as below whilst on the premises and discussing Walthamstow Trades Hall to the press and/or on social media.

I will:

- 1. Treat others with respect and value diversity
- 2. Avoid using offensive/insensitive language
- 3. Refrain from harassing, bullying and abusive behaviour
- 4. Respect confidentiality and ensure that confidential materials, including about individuals, are handled with care and sensitivity
- 5. Avoid bringing the Club and CIU into disrepute
- 6. Express my opinions with tact, avoiding conflict and argument
- 7. Make the Club Secretary aware of any potential Conflicts of Interest, so that they can be added to the Conflict of Interest log
- 8. Act within the Club's governing rules
- 9. Take reasonable care over health and safety for myself and others, particularly when organising an event on the premises

Making a complaint

A written statement or complaint to be made about the Member and handed or emailed to the Secretary within 7 calendar days of the incident.

- The club member who is the subject of the complaint will be given notice in writing that they have 7 calendar days to appear before the committee to explain their behaviour.

- The Committee can agree a membership suspension with immediate effect based on the representations, should further investigations be required, or take the decision to revoke membership.
- If a club member wishes to appeal a decision to revoke their membership they have 14 calendar days from receiving the written committee decision to do so. The appeal should be made in writing.
